# What Media Projects?

The media projects that you will work on will be mixed and varied in nature. While the majority of the projects will be undertaken “on location” somewhere in the wilds of Kerry, others will be studio based at our state of the art digital media centre at our Kerry College, Monavalley Campus.

The primary areas of media production will be video, photography, sound and design. All projects will be real-world projects that will respond to the needs of a client. They will have a defined end use and their production will be driven by a deadline.

# What Media Roles?

We will be recruiting 9 media interns in total, each of whom will work as part of a three person media production team. Each intern will have a defined role within the team. While the number of roles and specific skillsets required will be finalised when the projects are fully commissioned, we envisage that the following is a broad outline of the positions to be filled and the skillsets required.

### Video Production Crew:

- Video Director
- Video Camera & Lighting Operator
- Location Sound
- Video Editing & Grading

### Photography:

- Photographer (Portrait & Product) Studio based
- Mobile Video Journalist / Photographer
- Photo Editor

### Other:

- Graphic Designer
- Digital Content Creator
- Writer (Online Content & Video Scripts)

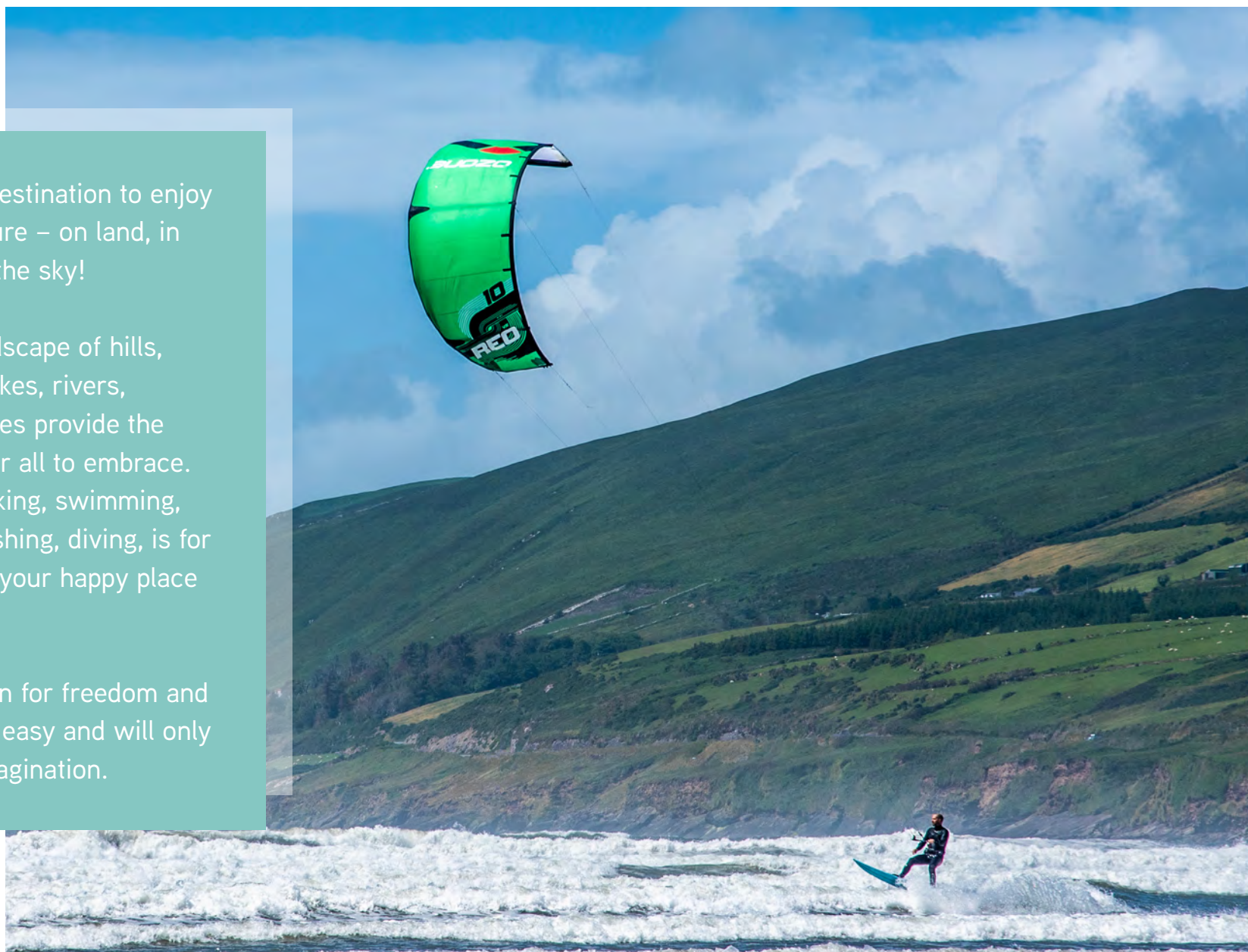


# The Kerry Experience

# Who Should Apply?

If you are a recent Graduate of a third level Media course and you have a specific skills set that you would like to enhance by working on a media production team, this may well be the opportunity of a lifetime for you.

If you are clear about the media production skills that you have and have a personal vision of how and why you would like to enhance and apply them, then we would like to hear from you.

## *What are the requirements?*

- Minimum Age 21+ (Having completed a third level degree, it is envisaged that all applicants will be a minimum of 21 years of age and over).
- Degree in a media related area.
- A defined existing media skillset.
- A piece of work that demonstrates this skillset.
- Excellent communication & interpersonal skills.
- Good numeracy skills.
- Good computer skills.
- Competent English (CEFR B1).
- A full driving licence is very desirable.
- A team player.
- Flexible to work non-standard hours.
- Mature applicant route available.
- Non-EU/EEA applicants must have permission to work in Ireland.
- Applicants may be requested to support their application with a letter of reference from your College or University.

- Applicants will individually attend an on-line interview.



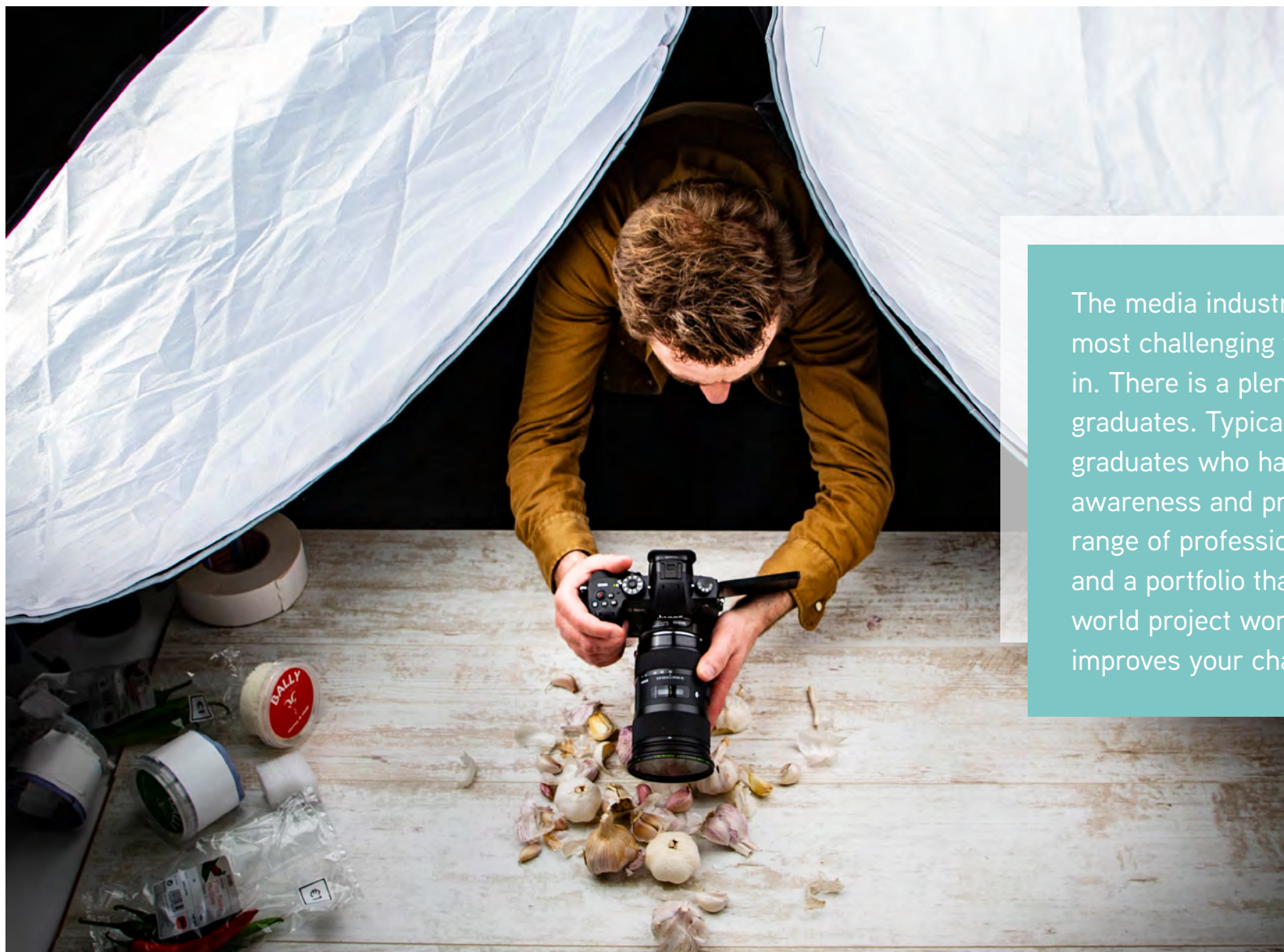
